Talking Points

All “Associates” receive access to the same benefits, regardless of the amount of their annual donation based on a fiscal year (July 1- June 30).

Levels of Giving for PA Programs:

\$1,000	Founder
\$500	Historian
\$250	Scribe

Levels of Giving for PA Constituent Organizations:

Includes: state chapters, caucuses, specialty groups, etc.

\$75	Less than 99 Members
\$150	100 – 249 Members
\$250	250+ Members

Why does the PAHx have different levels of giving for PA programs?

- The PAHx strives to provide our educational resources to all PA programs and PA students.
- We believe the best way to accommodate this is by offering levels of giving that would fit the various budgets of the PA programs.
- Each of the 277+ accredited programs have different class sizes, budgets, and funding models.
- In 2016, the PAHx surveyed the PA programs regarding the Society’s educational resources and our Associate Benefits. The request received from the programs was for several levels of giving instead of the previous \$500 only level option.
- The 3 levels of giving for the PA programs started in 2017 and continue to be well-received over the years.

Why are the levels of giving less for PA organizations than for PA programs?

- The 110+ state chapters and constituent organizations receive significantly less funding than the PA programs collect from student tuition.
- The size of state chapters and the other PA groups varies drastically.
- In 2020, the PAHx also surveyed the constituent organizations, and the results showed an interest in the Society’s historian resources.
- The PAHx has decided to develop 3 levels of giving for the constituent levels that is based on their membership size to accommodate the budget of all state chapters and constituent organizations budgets.
