Searching for a Video

The PA History Society Moving Image Collection is stored in two places:

- Featured videos on are the PAHx website (www.pahx.org) and,
- A complete catalog of videos is stored in the PastPerfect™ Database.

Searching for a “Featured” Video

To search for a video that is on the PAHx website, simply locate the **SEARCH** box in the lower right corner of any page on the website and type in the name of the person or subject you wish to search for.



***NOTE:** A website search will only pull up the featured videos. If the website **SEARCH** results do not display the video that you are looking for, please visit the complete Moving Image Collection catalog available on the PastPerfect™ Database.

Viewing Video Collection on the PastPerfect™ Database

Once on the Video Collection webpage (<https://pahx.org/videos/>), please click on the gold highlighted link to open the PastPerfect™ Database.

VIDEO COLLECTION

The Videos – Moving Image Collection includes film and video created by various organizations, institutions and individuals and then gifted to the Society over time. Some are copyrighted and commercially produce while others are non-commercial or privately produced. The films are mostly 35mm color while the videos exist in both analog and digital formats both black and white and color. Most of the holdings from this collection have been reformatted and placed in the Society’s digital archival collection.



Viewing Video Collection on the PastPerfect™ Database

If you want to search for someone or something specific, locate the search menu on the top of the screen. Click on **Advanced Search**.



On the following page locate the search boxes to the left of the screen.

Find the box labeled **Collection**. It is the last one in the column.

In the **Collection** field, write "Digital Moving Image". *Make sure to include the quotations*. This will ensure that your search will be only among the PAHx Moving Image Collection.

Next locate the search field that will best fit the desired results.

If you know the title or the partial title of the video you are searching for, you would choose the **Title** field.

If you are looking for a video with a certain person in it, you would use either the **People** field or **Description** field.

Then press the SEARCH button.

***NOTE:** Some people might be listed under their full first name, even if they go by a nickname. Make sure to try different variants of a person's name (ex. Will or Bob for William, and vice versa).
