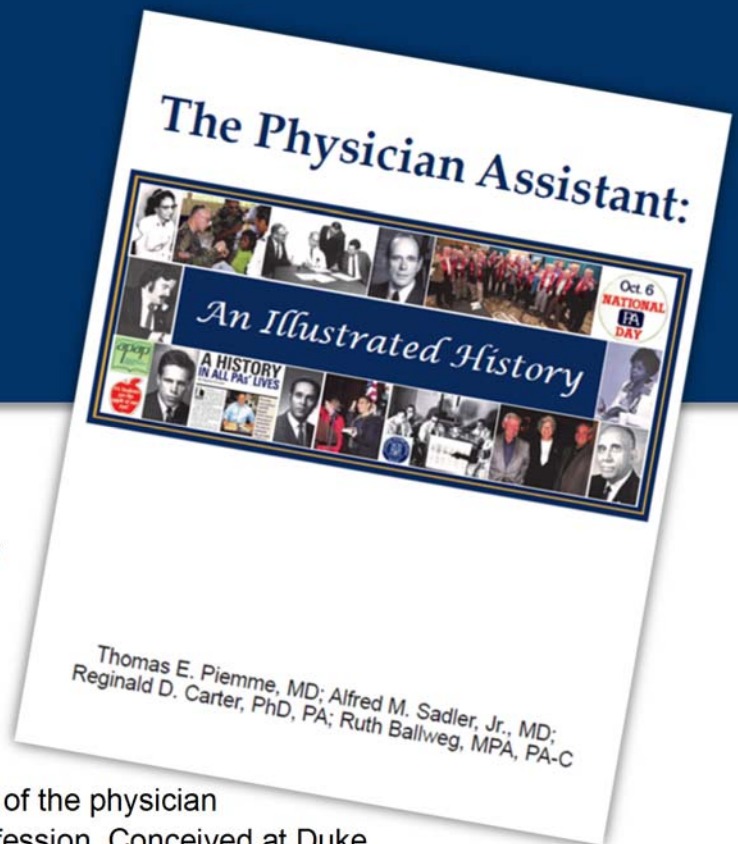

assistant profession. Conceived at Duke

University in 1965, in response to a shortage of generalist physicians, the concept of the assistant to the physician was endorsed by the medical profession and embraced by the public. Growth was stimulated by the Federal government, leading to a rapid proliferation of training across the Nation. With the formation of a system of accreditation of training programs by the American Medical Association, and the development of a certification examination of graduates by the National Board of Medical Examiners, the concept was rapidly adopted by state legislatures until it became universal.

This book is a *rich resource*
for educators to use when
teaching the *history of the*
PA profession.

It has ultimately taken a
place as an integral part
of American medical
practice. The physician
assistant has filled a
void in access to care
in underserved
communities, and will
play a vital role as 30

million newly insured patients enter the health care system
