

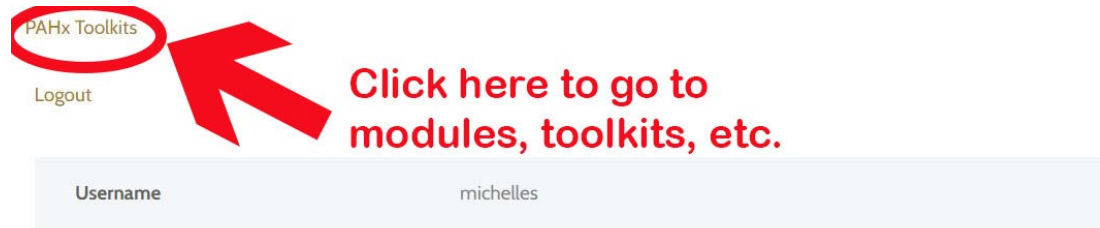
Accessing Associates Only Page – Educational Learning Modules, Historian Toolkit, and Celebration Planner:

Go to www.pahx.org

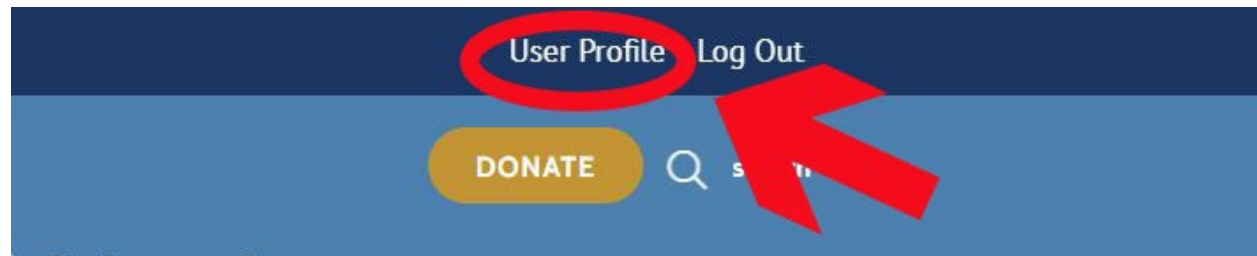
Log in with your PAHx Account username and password. (See: [Signing into a PAHx Account](#))

After you sign in, you will automatically be taken to the Profile page.

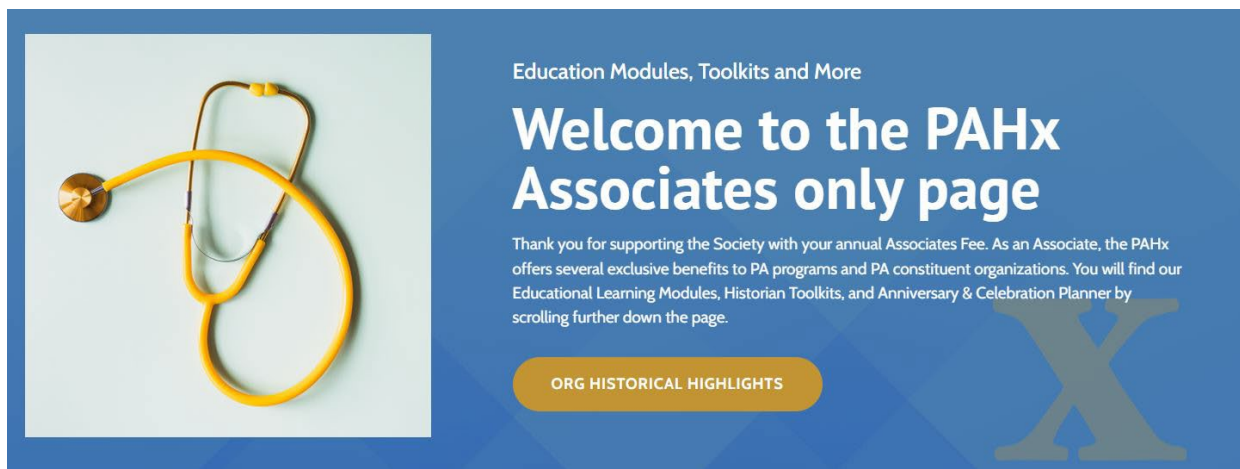
Once on the Profile page, click on the gold “PAHx Toolkits” link.



If you are signed in and not on the Profile page, look at the top right corner of the website. Click on the “User Profile” to be taken to the Profile page.
