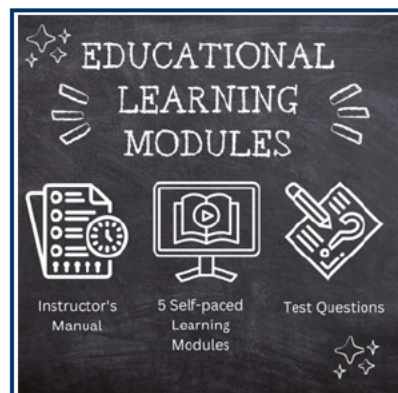


PAHx Educational Materials
