Searching for an Oral History

The PA History Society Oral History Collection is stored in three places: featured oral histories are on the PAHx website (www.pahx.org), our video recorded histories are on our Vimeo page (<https://vimeo.com/pahx>) and the complete collection of interviews is stored in the PastPerfect™ Database.

Searching for an Oral History

To search for an oral history, simply locate SEARCH button (with the magnifying glass by it) in the top right corner of any page on the website and type in the name of the person or subject you wish to search for.

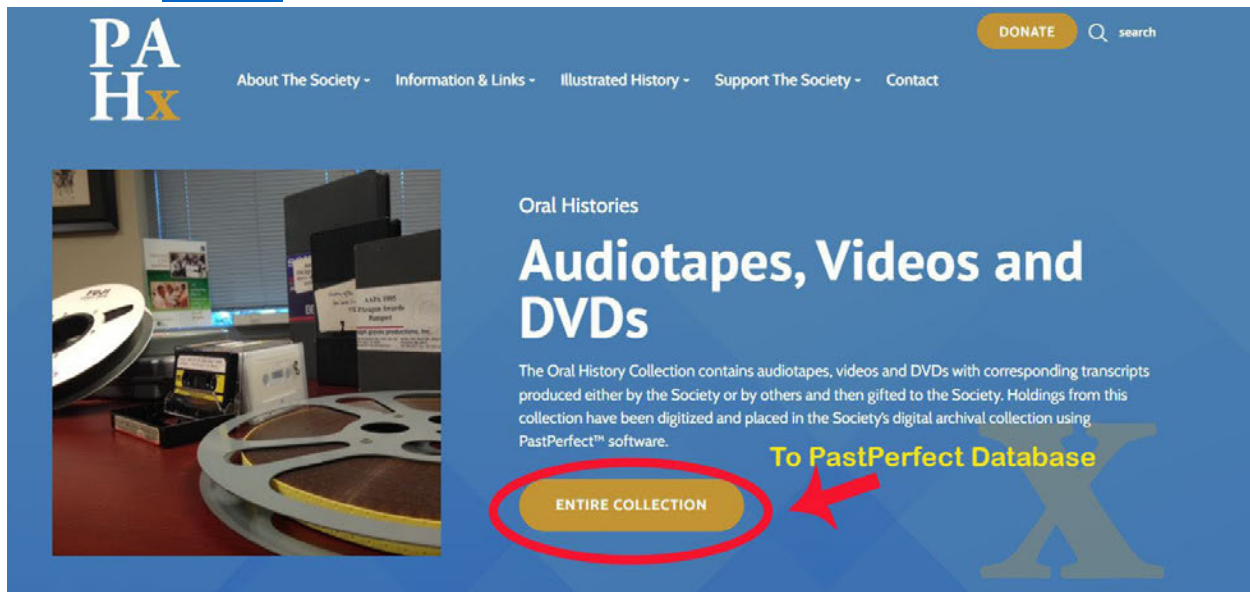

Search Boxes

In the box called "Title" write the name of the person that you are searching for. This can be either first name, last name, or full name. Then press the blue SEARCH button at the bottom of the search boxes.

***NOTE:** Some people might be listed under their full first name, even if they go by a nickname. Make sure to try different variants of a person's name (ex. Will or Bob for William, and vice versa).
